


MINUTES of the 2016 AUTUMN FEN MEETING

Call summary: H2020: Twinning project opportunity (call opens in May 2017, deadline 15.11.2017)

Twinning aims at significantly strengthening a defined field of research in a university or research organization from a Widening country by linking it with at least two internationally-leading research institutions in other Member States or Associated Countries. Duration: up to 3 years Budget per project: 1 mio EUR



Eligible costs: personel costs, subcontracting (training), travel and subsistence costs, networking

Applicants: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia. Partners: EU Member States, Associated countries, Non-EU non-Associated countries
