



## News from The Millennium Project Summary for the Foresight Europe Network Meeting on June 12<sup>th</sup> 2018 in Tampere

- Helped create a conference at Harvard and Boston Universities on relation of historians, philosophers, and STS (Science technology and society) scholars with futurists and futures research see: https://grapplingwiththefutures.com/Node chairs from Bulgaria, Pakistan, Brussels Area, and Silicon Valley attended.
- Signed two MOUs with:
  - 1) Instituto Atlántico de Gobierno (IADG) to help train future government leaders in Latin America and Spain lead by the former President of Spain; and
  - 2) Awecademy cooperating to develop learning modules on futures concepts, issues, and methods.
- Briefed the Science and Technology Committee of the Organization of American States
  on how to create their regional foresight scanning and collective intelligence system and
  informally agreeing to continue collaboration with OAS on their futures work.
- Exploring the possibilities of new studies:
  - 1) Anticipatory Governance of transition from Artificial Narrow to Artificial General Intelligence;
  - 2) Public's roles in SIMAD (Single Individual Massively Destructive) prevention;
     and
  - 3) After several more national work/tech 2050 workshops will design an RTD for rating the suggestions to address the issues raised in the three Future Work/Technology 2050 Global Scenarios.
- Reviews of the State of the Future 19.1 in Foresight, World Futures Review, Harvard Future Society, and Humanity+
- Next annual MP Planning committee to be held in Bolivia October 8-9 followed by a public conference
